Manitoba Health Licensing Requirements

Note: Applicants must be licensed as Aero-medical Attendant with Manitoba Emergency Health Services Branch prior to start of employment. Fast Air will provide assistance in this process to successful candidates.

- Nurse applicants must have successfully graduated with a Registered Nurse Diploma and obtained either a Emergency Nursing Certificate and/or a Critical Care Certificate and have a minimum of 2 years experience in an acute care hospital setting.
- Paramedic applicants must have successfully graduated from a Canadian Medical Association accredited Advance Care Paramedic program and have a minimum of 2 years experience within an ALS system.
- Criminal record and vulnerable person clearance check within the last 60 days
- Manitoba Child Abuse Registry clearance check within the last 60 days
- Current BCLS-HC Certification required
- Current ACLS Certification required
- Current TNCC or ITLS Certification required
- Canadian Aerospace and Aero-medical Transport Association Certification

Fast Air Medevac is currently seeking applications from individuals able to work on a casual basis to cover a few days a month and/or available to assist with off-load delays.
